You maintain that the owner had decided to sub-meter the apartments some time ago, and Quad Logic's electric charges, which are outrageous, are included on your rent statements. You believe that Quad Logic is defrauding the tenants at IPN, and you ask the Attorney General to investigate this matter.

It appears that there is ongoing litigation pertaining to the regulatory status of the housing accommodations at IPN. Accordingly, it would be premature to respond more fully to the instant inquiry.
